### Program Effectiveness Data

• **Credentialing Examination Pass Rate** (five-year average) - The number of graduates who pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technology (ARRT) or an unrestricted state licensing examination (Radiography, Radiation Therapy, and Magnetic Resonance) compared with the number of graduates whose first attempt take the examination occurs within six months of graduation.

Year	Percent passing on 1st attempt	Number of students
2013	100%	5 of 5 passed on 1st attempt
2014	89%	8 of 9 passed on the 1 <sup>st</sup> attempt
2015	90%	9 out of 10 passed in the 1 <sup>st</sup> attempt
2016	62%	8 out of 13 passed on the 1 <sup>st</sup> attempt (we had one graduate #14 to take exam after 6 months and pass on the first attempt as well)
2017	67%	6 out of 9 passed on 1 <sup>st</sup> attempt
<b>5 year average</b>	78%	36 of 46 passed on 1st attempt

• **Job Placement Rate** (five-year average) - Per JRCERT Standard Five – Objective 5.2, job placement rate is defined as the number of graduates employed in the radiologic sciences compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the radiologic sciences.

The JRCERT has defined not actively seeking employment as: 1) graduate fails to communicate with program officials regarding employment status after multiple attempts, 2) graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation, 3) graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours, 4) graduate is on active military duty, and/or 5) graduate is continuing education.

Year	Percent job placement	Number of students
2013	100%	5 of 5 employed within 12 months of graduation
2014	89%	8 of 9 employed within 12 months of graduation
2015	100%	9 of 9 employed within 12 months of graduation; one graduate (#10) did not communicate with program.
2016	100%	10 out of 10 employed within 12 months of graduation
2017	100%	8 out of 8 employed within 12 months of graduation
<b>5 year average</b>	98%	40 of 41 employed within 12 months of graduation

• **Program Completion Rate** (calculated annually) - The number of students who complete the program within a cohort compared to the number who enrolled in the cohort initially.

Reporting Period: January 1 – December 31, 2017

<b>Percent completion</b>	<b>Number of students</b>
71%	Seven students started the program in 2011. Five out of seven students graduated in 2013. The 2 drops were due to career goal changes.
75%	12 students started the program in 2012. 9 of the 12 graduated in the reporting period 2014. One had a career goal change, one was due to an illness and the other was due to a disciplinary action.
77%	13 students started the program in 2013. 10 out of 13 graduated in the reporting period 2015. One had a career goal change/personal illness, one was due to a family illness, and the other was due to a disciplinary action.
100%	14 students started the program in 2014 and 14 graduated in the reporting period of 2016.
90%	10 students started the program in 2015 and 9 students graduated in the reporting period of 2017.
